## WILD PIGS OF NAMIBIA

**Two species of wild pig occur in Namibia.** The warthog is well-known and widespread throughout much of the country, while the bushpig occurs only in the northeast.

## PANGOLINS OF NAMIBIA

Pangolins are small, secretive and nocturnal, and are rarely seen by people. They feed on ants and termites and thus play an important role in the environment. One pangolin species, the ground pangolin, occurs in Namibia.

## SENGIS OF NAMIBIA

**Sengis are also known as elephant-shrews.** Although they look similar to shrews or rodents, these tiny mammals form a unique scientific order, the Macroscelidea.

## CRAKES OF NAMIBIA

## HEDGEHOGS OF NAMIBIA

**Hedgehogs** are small and adorable nocturnal mammals with a voracious appetite for insects and other small prey. Only one species of hedgehog occurs in Namibia.
