The name cuckoo is onomatopoeic, meaning that the word is derived from a similar sound, in this case the distinct call of many cuckoos. The African cuckoo has the most typical call of the cuckoos occurring in Namibia, consisting of a series of hoots that sound very similar to the word cuckoo.
